

OPEN BELGIAN Nationals “OK-Dinghy” 16 & 17 SEPTEMBER 2023

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by :

1. The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024, issued by World Sailing.
2. The *OK Dinghy Class Rules*.

Appendix P may apply.

If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats and helmsman registered by their national OK Dinghy association, and by their national authority. Belgian competitors will present their sailing license at entry registration.
- 3.2 To enter the regatta, register for the event at manage to sail website : Manage2sail.com before september 15. Entry completes by registration at the race office and payment of the entry fee.

4 ENTRY FEES (per person)

Participation to the regatta: 15 €

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Entry and registration : Saturday September 16th : 10:30 to 12:30.
- 5.2 First warning signal : Saturday September 16th : 13:00.
- 5.3 First warning signal on Sunday 17th will be presented on the notice board before 19:00 on Saturday.
- 5.4 No warning signal will be given after 15:00 on Sunday.
- 5.5 Number of races scheduled : 8. Decision or failure of the race committee to reach this number shall not be ground for redress.
- 5.6 Prize giving : as soon as possible after the last race on Sunday.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat has a valid measurement certificate and will produce this at request of the Jury.

7 VENUE

Lake Galgenweel (left bank Antwerp, Belgium)

8 THE COURSES

Courses will be triangular including upwind, downwind beats and reaches.

9 SOCIAL EVENTS

Are organised by the Belgian OK Dinghy Association.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the first 3 competitors.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EURO 1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
